Crown Him with Many Crowns

“His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns”—Revelation 19:12
“The four and twenty elders fall down before Him that sat on the throne and worship Him that liveth forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne.”—Revelation 4:10

No greater joy will ever be afforded to redeemed souls than to participate in the coronation of Christ. To crown the high King of Heaven; to worship Him, and to cast our crowns at His feet!
