Heaven Sent Revival is America's Only Hope!

Our hope is not in human government; our nation must return to God. God said, "Return unto me and I will return unto you" (Malachi 3:7). Heaven-sent revival in our nation must begin with revival in our hearts.

Five Keys to Personal Revival

1. Get right with God – We must have a genuine and intimate relationship with Him (Ps. 80:7). Confess and repent of any hidden sins or compromises, indifference, coldness or lukewarmness. Seek a spirit of humility and brokenness before God, become intimate with God through worshipful prayer.
2. Get right with man – Maintain a loving, clear and honest relationship with all others (Matt. 5:23, 24; 1 John 4:20, 21). Confess and repent of all resentment or bitterness. Apologize for wrong thoughts or bitter attitudes against anyone. Release forgiveness from the heart. (Facts may not change, but attitudes must.) Confess and repent of all pride of class, race or prejudice. Agree with the heart of God by accepting a soul burden for all people.
3. Get right with yourself – Let God give you peace of mind and inner healing. Forgive and accept forgiveness for the past and face the future with hope in Christ (Is. 26:3; Phil 3:13). Settle all doubts about your soul's peace, have faith that you are "accepted in the beloved" (Eph. 1:6). Accept the unchangeable things in life: Circumstances of birth, parents, appearance, body chemistry, etc. God is our Maker. He has a purpose in all things. Trust the grace of God to overcome your hurts, and disappointments and turn them into your life message. Accept yourself for what you are in God's eyes, and you will be free to turn your attention to God and to others who need Him.
4. Obey the Holy Spirit – Bend to His will and follow through with every leading (Rom. 8:14; Luke 9:23-25). Surrender to the Lordship of Christ, and be cleansed, sanctified and filled with Holy Spirit power, fire, and love. Yield quickly to every prompting of the Spirit to read, pray, witness and obey. Never grieve the Holy Spirit.
5. Go public with your witness for Christ – Share your story continually, allowing the Holy Spirit to reveal the love of Christ in you (Acts 1:8; Luke 9:23; Dan. 12:3). Exercise your soul burden with intercessory prayer and travail of soul. Pray for the overflowing love of Christ. Learn the basic scriptures of the Plan of Salvation. Carry them and/or memorize them. Write up a tract of your salvation story. Share it everywhere as the Spirit leads you.
