Run and Don't Look Back!

"Remember Lot's Wife. . ." "No man having put his hand to the plow and looking back is fit for the Kingdom of God. . ." "flee from the wrath to come. . ." "flee also youthful lusts but follow righteousness." "let us run with patience the race that is set before us Looking unto Jesus. . ."—Luke 17:32; 9:62; Matthew 3:7; 2 Timothy 2:22; Hebrews 12;1,2.

If material goods and pleasures have become more important to us than the glory of God and His kingdom then we should run from that worldly trap. Run and don't look back! Overcome him by the Word of God, by your testimony, and by the Blood of the Lamb. Run from listening to Satan's deceitful words, they are not your thoughts, they are his lies! Flee to the loving arms of God.
